Our safeguarding values:


- Protecting children from maltreatment
- Preventing impairment of children's health and development
- Ensuring that children grow up in circumstances consistent with the provision of safe and effective care.
- Taking action to enable all children have the best outcomes.

Our Policy

- The welfare of the child is paramount.
- No child or group of children must be treated any less favourably than others in being able to access services which meet their particular needs.
- All children without exception have the right to protection from abuse regardless of gender, ethnicity, disability, sexuality or beliefs.
- Our policy is renewed, approved and endorsed by the board of trustee annually or when legislation changes.
- Our policy applies to all trustees, staff and volunteers.
- Every child and parent is informed about our policy and procedures prior to any working activity.
- We take all concerns, and allegations of abuse seriously and respond appropriately. This may require a referral to the children's social care services, the independent local authority designated officer (LADO) for allegations against staff, trustee and other volunteers and in emergencies the police.
- We are fully committed to a safe recruitment, selection, and vetting process.
- All staffs and volunteers must adhere to all principles, legislation and guidance that underpin this policy.
- All members of staff, volunteers or third parties working with CCA must adhere to all associated policies and procedures which promote children's safety and welfare e.g with regards health and safety, anti-bullying, protection of children online and photography.
